CRIMINAL HISTORY

As part of the licensing process, QRL requires every applicant to obtain a **National Police Certificate** from their local police station and attach the original certificate to this application. You must disclose any conviction against you imposed in any country.

A prior criminal history does not prevent a person from obtaining a licence, but any prior convictions are taken into account when deciding whether an applicant is an appropriate person to be involved in thoroughbred racing in Queensland. This information may be disclosed to QRL personnel and government departments and authorities.

1. All the information contained in this application form is true and correct in every particular.
2. I have read the Australian Rules of Racing and QRL’s Local Rules of Racing (“the Rules of Racing”). I am aware that is my obligation as a rider’s agent to update myself in relation to any rule changes and to abide by those new rules. I also agree to be bound by the Policies of QRL and the Rules of Racing (which can be accessed at QRL’s website).
3. I am not currently subject to any disciplinary action initiated by any other Principal Racing Authority (PRA) in Australia or New Zealand. I will immediately inform QRL should any other PRA initiate disciplinary action against me.
4. I understand that if I do not pay any amount owed to QRL within the required time, QRL may set off this debt against any other money owing to me.
5. I authorise QRL to disclose information provided by me in this application form to:
 - a. The PRA that licensed me;
 - b. The emergency contact person nominated in this form;
 - c. State and Federal Government departments and regulatory authorities;
 - d. The Credit Reference Association of Australia (CRAA);
 - e. Persons currently unknown for the purpose of complying with statutory obligations requiring QRL to disclose information.
