## OVERVIEW OF LICENSING PROCEDURE FOR JOCKEYS

1) Answer all questions and sign the application form

2) Attach the following –

- A **National Police Certificate**, which you may obtain from your local police station
- Payment to Queensland Racing Limited for \$270.00 being the application processing fee
- A recent passport sized photograph of yourself
- A photocopy of proof of your identity e.g. drivers licence, birth certificate etc.
- Medical Certificate – **must be completed on a Queensland Racing Jockey Medical every 12 months.**
- If you are not an Australian citizen proof of your right to work e.g. certificate of residence/ photocopy of visa.

3) Deliver the application to a Queensland Racing Limited Regional office or post to Queensland Racing Limited, PO Box 63, SANDGATE QLD 4017

4) As a licensed Jockey you may participate in:

- General track work sessions and
- Jump outs;
- Barrier Trials
- Races

### CRIMINAL HISTORY

**N.B- Sch 3 Racing Act 2002-“conviction” of an offence means being found guilty of an offence, on a plea of guilty or otherwise, whether or not a conviction is recorded.**

As part of the licensing process, Queensland Racing Limited requires every applicant to obtain a **National Police Certificate** [or equivalent] from their local police station and attach the original certificate to this application. If you are not an Australian citizen, you must obtain a police clearance from your country of origin. You must disclose any conviction against you imposed in any country.

A prior criminal history does not prevent a person from obtaining a licence, but any prior convictions are taken into account when deciding whether an applicant is an appropriate person to be involved in thoroughbred racing in Queensland. This information may be disclosed to Queensland Racing Limited personnel and government departments and authorities.

1. All information that I have provided to Queensland Racing Limited in this application form is true and correct in every particular.
2. I understand that Queensland Racing Limited will rely upon the information I have provided in this application form for the purpose of determining whether I am an appropriate person to receive a jockey's licence.
3. I understand that Queensland Racing Limited may take disciplinary action against me in the event that the information I have provided in this application is false or misleading in any particular, and that disciplinary action may include the revocation of any licence issued to me.
4. I have read the Australian Rules of Racing and Queensland Racing Limited's Local Rules of Racing ("the Rules of Racing") and it is my obligation as a jockey to update myself in relation to Queensland Racing Limited's policies and any rule changes and to abide by those policies and rules of racing.
5. I am not currently subject to any disciplinary action initiated by any other Principal Racing Authority in Australia or overseas and I will immediately inform Queensland Racing Limited should any Principal Racing Authority in Australia or overseas initiate disciplinary action against me.
6. I understand that if I do not pay any amount owed to Queensland Racing Limited within the required time, Queensland Racing Limited may set off this debt against any prize money due and owing to me through the Central Prize Money System administered by Queensland Racing Limited.
7. I authorise Queensland Racing Limited to make deposits via Electronic Funds Transfer into the bank account nominated by me in this application form. I understand that if my bank account details change, I will have to notify Queensland Racing Limited in writing of the new bank account details and that until I notify Queensland Racing Limited in writing of the change, Queensland Racing Limited may still make deposits into the account nominated in this form.
8. For GST purposes relating to the supply of services by me (the Supplier), to Queensland Racing Limited (the Recipient):
  - a. I, (the Supplier) acknowledge that I am registered for GST purposes and I will notify Queensland Racing Limited in writing if I ceased to be registered for GST purposes;
  - b. I (the Supplier) will not issue tax invoices in relation to any prize money (supplies) that Queensland Racing Limited may have to pay me;
  - c. Queensland Racing Limited (the Recipient) can issue tax invoices in respect of prize money (supplies) that it has to pay me;
  - d. I (the Supplier) will not issue tax invoices in respect of the supplies;
  - e. I understand that Queensland Racing Limited is registered for GST purposes and that it will notify me in writing immediately if it ceases to be GST registered or it is otherwise unable to prepare Recipient Created Tax Invoices (RCTI) on my behalf;
  - f. I understand that Queensland Racing Limited can only issue an RCTI on my behalf if it complies with the requirements established under legislation.
11. I authorise Queensland Racing Limited to disclose information provided by me in this application form to:
  - a. All Principal Racing Authorities in Australia and overseas;
  - b. The persons specified in this application form;
  - c. State and Federal Government departments and regulatory authorities;
  - d. Persons currently unknown for the purpose of complying with statutory obligations requiring Queensland Racing Limited to disclose information.
12. I consent to Queensland Racing Limited contacting all licensed totalisator operators and licensed racing bookmakers in Australia and overseas, for the purpose of determining whether I am betting on races. I also consent to those third parties disclosing information to Queensland Racing Limited about any betting that I engage in.
13. I consent to Queensland Racing Limited contacting other Australian and overseas Racing Control Bodies and I consent to those bodies disclosing any information that may be requested at any time by Queensland Racing Limited.

14. I acknowledge that Queensland Racing Limited collates personal information about me as part of its licensing and disciplinary processes and when auditing my performance as a track work rider. I authorise Queensland Racing Limited to disclose information relating to my disciplinary history in Queensland to other Principal Racing Authorities in Australia and overseas.
15. I understand that if I make misleading statements to Queensland Racing Limited, that I will be subject to disciplinary action that may result in the revocation of my trackwork rider's licence.
